God chose to create you because he wants a relationship with you.

Jeremiah 29:11-13 *God is a promise-keeper.*

What are the promises from God in these verses?

What part must we play in finding God?

What does it mean to seek God with all of your heart?

Matthew 6:24-34 *God is the provider.*

What kinds of things do you worry about?

How could those things distract you from seeking God?

What does it mean to seek first His kingdom and His righteousness?

Matthew 7:7-14 *God is a good, good Father.*

What does it take to find God according to these scriptures?

What is your relationship with your father like?

(How) Do you think it affects your view of God as a Father?

Why is the road to life narrow and only a few find it?

Mark 12:28-32 *God is a loving God.*

What is the greatest command? Do you feel you (know how to) love God this way?

What do you think it means to love your neighbor as yourself?

Do you have relationships with Christians that extend beyond church services?

Luke 11:1-4 *God is a listening God.*

Do you have a special/certain place where you like to go pray?

Why do you think the prayer life of Jesus impressed his disciples so much?

How can we deal with temptation? How often should we be praying?

Let's look at an example of the power of prayer:

Acts 16:16-34 *Prayer can change our lives and others' lives.*

Even during a bad situation, Paul and Silas were praying and singing to God.

God caused a miracle to happen, and a window was opened for the gospel to be preached.

The One God revealed Himself (through Paul and Silas) to the jailer and his family.
