

One God Revealed in Jesus

OPENING QUESTION: What is your view of God? What do you think He is like?

Genesis 1:1-5 *God is the Great Creator.*

Do you believe that God created everything? The Bible describes God as a creator as well as a heavenly father. What is your relationship with your earthly father like? (How) do you think it affects your view of God?

John 1:1-5, 14 *The Word of God*

What do these verses say about Jesus? How did God reveal Himself to mankind?

Since Jesus is God in the flesh, his characteristics are God's as well:

Luke 4:31-37 *God has power and authority.*

How is the power and authority of God displayed here?

Are you willing to give God authority over your life?

Luke 4:38-44 *God has love and conviction.*

What needs did Jesus take care of this day?

How important is it to have regular times of solitude? What did Jesus say was his mission?

Luke 5:1-11 *God has a calling (for you).*

How did Jesus build a relationship with Simon (Peter) before calling him?

Why do you think Simon (Peter) was afraid?

What fears or worries do you have in life right now?

Is there anything that you would not be willing to leave or give up for Jesus?

Luke 5:12-16 *God has humility and compassion.*

How did Jesus go the "extra mile" for this leper? (HINT: touching him)

Are there areas of your life (relational, emotional, physical) that you need God to heal? What can we pray about for you? Are you willing to imitate Jesus in "often withdrawing to pray"?

Personal Decisions:

What have you learned about the character of God from the interactions of Jesus in these passages? What is your current prayer life like?
